- SB 2480 — Restricted coverage for agricultural workers
- HB 46 — COLA increases for injured workers
- HB 541 — Increased permanent partial disability awards
- HB 865 — Reduced the computation of earnings for PERS
- HB 866 — Revisiting TRS (Teacher Retirement System)

- SSB 3169 — Made contractors liable when sub-contractors fail to pay W.C. premiums
- HB 1258 — Against contracting out DSHS services
- SHB 236 — Provided a salary increase for state employees
- HB 358 — Expanded access to community college's for high school completion
- HB 781 — Against requiring offshore companies to comply with OSHA
- HB 454 — Requires insurance policies be readable
- HB 1570 — Supported higher interest rates on loans
- SB 2333 — Limited rights of citizens to sue third parties when products cause harm
- SJR 110 — Against limiting special sessions
- HJR 10 — Supported congressional representation for WA D.C.
- HJM 15 — Against a national constitutional convention

- SHB 31 — Discriminatory exclusion of agricultural workers from COLA
- SHB 31 — Against allowing private insurers into W.C. system
- HB 137 — Shut down an attempt to allow large increases in the percentage banks can charge for loans and credit cards
- HB 160 — Restoring a 12% limit on revolving credit cards
- HB 166 — Guaranteeing bargaining rights for school workers
- HB 660 — Providing benefits to workers in labor disputes
- EHB 677 — Against the use of strikebreakers in ferry dispute
- ESB 3359 — Requiring binding arbitration in ferry contract disputes and not placing workers under civil service
- SSB 3636 — Against denying public accountability
- HJM 1 — Voted for a constitutional convention

- HB 796 — Against forcing apprentices to fund the costs of the Apprenticeship Division of L&I
- ESB 3944 — Against increasing restrictions on U.I. benefits to workers in labor disputes
- HJM 1 — Against a new amendment to the US Constitution mandating a balanced federal budget
- ESHB 1127 — Against negative changes in Senate W.C. law
- ESB 4831 — Against reclassifying shoreline for an offshore oil-rig construction site
- ESB 3944 — Provided payment of U.I. benefits during lockouts
- ESHB 1226 — Protects seniority in the state civil service system
- ESB 4216 — Against changing the sunset date for extended unemployment benefits
- ESB 4250 — Re-imposed a 5.4% sales tax on food and a 4% surcharge on all other taxes except timber and property
- ESB 5007 — Against adding unused annual leave to the calculation of average final compensation for PERS

- EHB 107 — Voted to allow public and non-profit hospitals to form groups to self insure for individual insurance
- HB 765 — Provides annual COLA's to workers' compensation benefits for claims established after July 1, 1971
- (Excused) ESHB 257 — Eliminating the \$150 per year exemption for agricultural workers under workers' compensation
- ESHB 134 — Would have repealed certain negative changes to the civil service law
- EHB 606 — Makes collective bargaining agreements binding on successor employers
- ESSB 3108 — Restoring collective bargaining rights to WA state ferry employees
- ESSB 3042 — Against providing collective bargaining for higher education faculty
- SSB 3248 — Equal pay for equal work

1984

- E2SSB 4831 — Voted to exempt workers on farms employing four or fewer employees
- ESB 4421 — Against reducing the timber excise tax from 6.5% to 5%
- HB 1219 — Granting collective bargaining rights to faculty at community colleges
- EHB 1355 — Authorizing payroll deductions for political action committees for state employees
- ESSB 4403 — Remove charity care cost pooling from bill
- SSB 4381 — Voted to shorten the deadline for voter registration from 30 to 15 days prior to an election
