I-777 is simply union busting.

Federal law requires unions to represent everyone, so the dues-paying union members would be forced to subsidize those who take union services for free.

States that have enacted such measures have suffered immediate declines in wages and benefits, a measurably diminished standard of living and substandard legal protections for ALL workers.
