Companies aren't supposed to attack workers who want a union, but Rite Aid and other employers are doing it every day.

When 650 workers at Rite Aid's distribution center in Lancaster, CA, wanted to join a union, the company threatened and fired them. After workers went ahead and voted to join the ILWU last March, Rite Aid continued the attacks. Now the company is refusing to sign a first contract.

The federal government charged Rite Aid with 49 labor law violations, but let the company off with a slap on the wrist.

America needs the *Employee Free Choice Act*, a new law that would protect everyone's rights at work, and make it possible to create better jobs.
