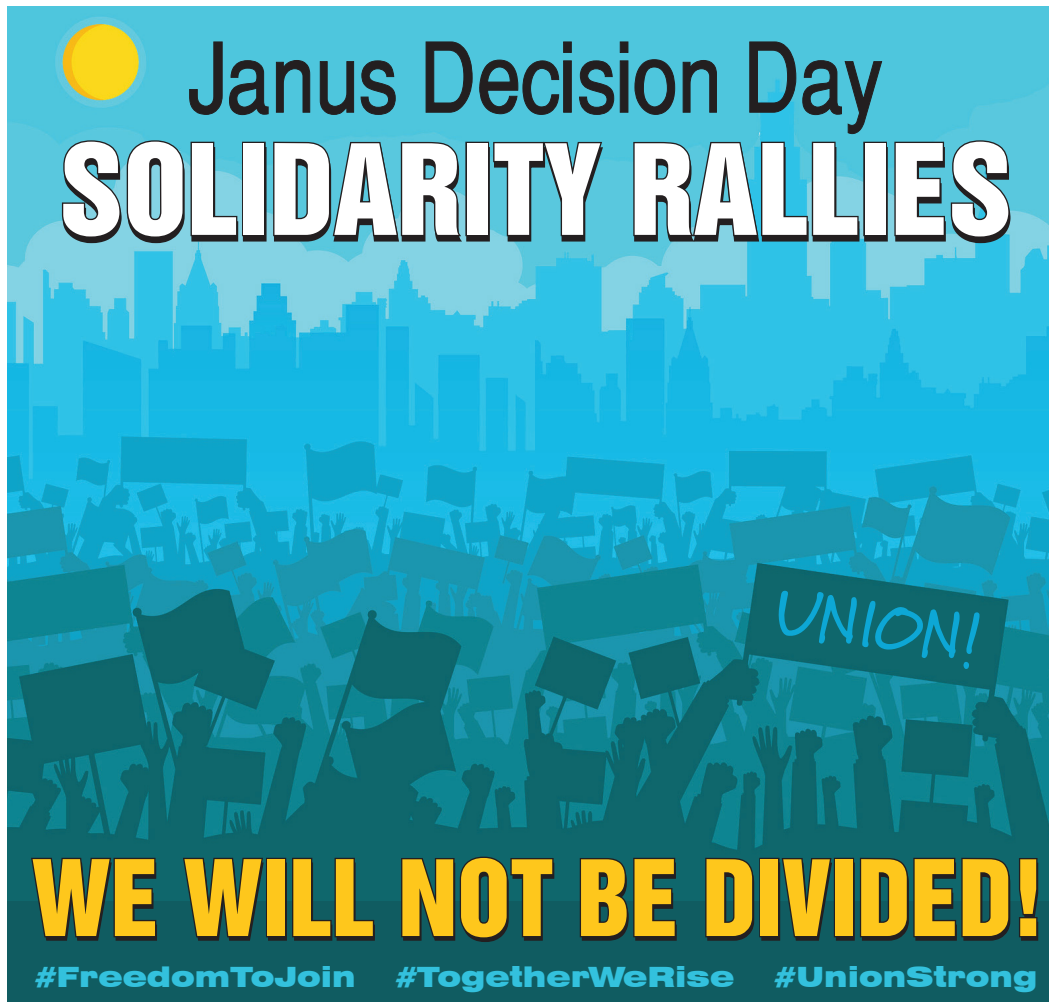


At 7 a.m. on a Monday between now and June 25, the Supreme Court will rule on *Janus v. AFSCME*.
