Carolyn Long was a unionized grocery worker (UFCW) who put herself through college to become a political science professor at WSU–Vancouver. In her first campaign as a Democratic candidate for Congress in 2018, she came very close to unseating Republican Rep. Jaime Herrera Beutler. Since then, Herrera Beutler has gotten even more extreme. She was the only U.S. Representative from Washington who voted “yes” on Trump’s anti-immigrant border wall bill¹ and she voted against legislation to strengthen unions.² Herrera Beutler has so stridently defended Donald Trump that *The Columbian* wrote: “The Battle Ground Republican has chosen party over country and obfuscation over transparency.”³
